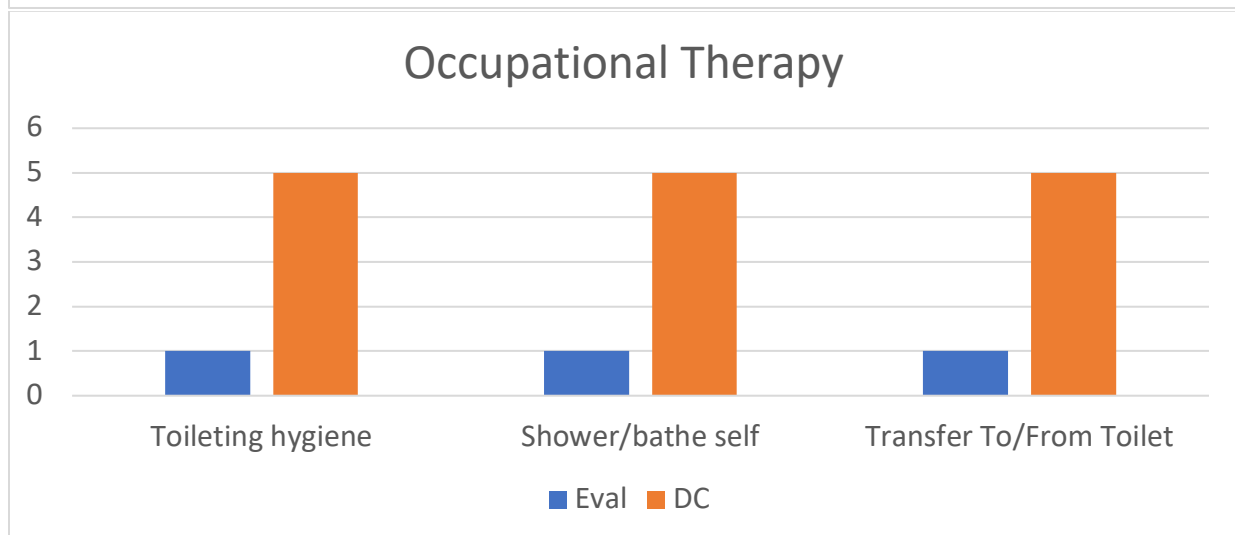
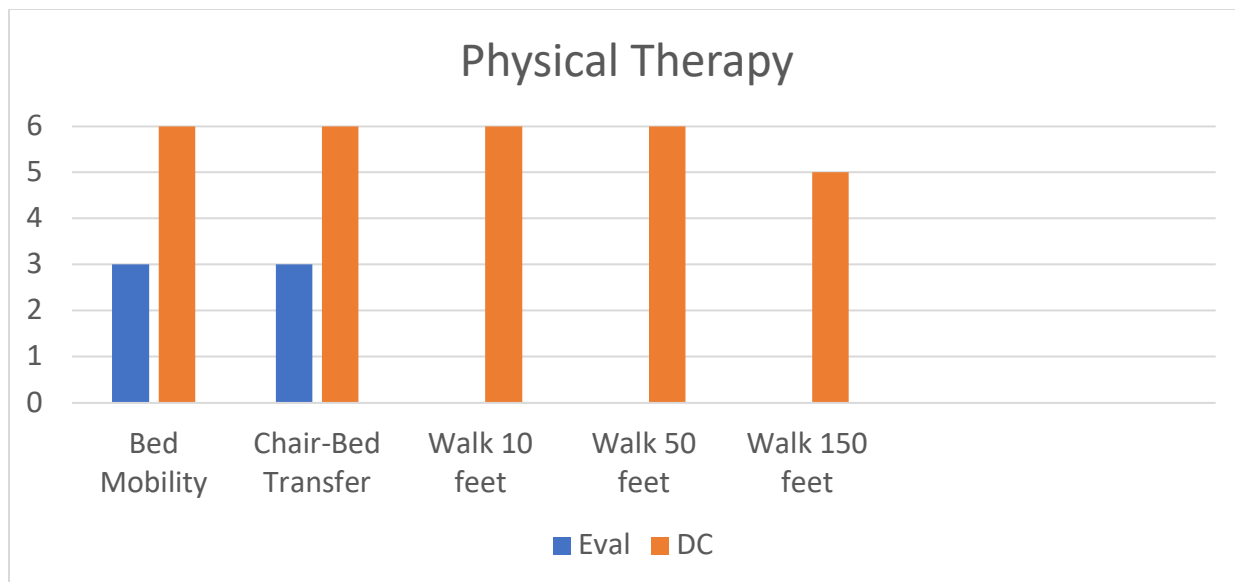


Mrs. Virginia Clossman is a 80 year old female who had a history of falls in the past and was admitted to HCA North Cypress on 3/28/24 due to suspected fracture of left sacrum, acute cystitis, and a UTI. She was treated for these conditions with positive results and then discharged to Park Manor CyFair for post-acute skilled Nursing and Rehab services on 4/2/24.

Mrs. Clossman was evaluated by Physical, Occupational, and Speech therapy services and the initial assessments indicated that Mrs. Clossman required Mod A for bed mobility, Mod A for transfers, Max A for bathing, Total A for LB dressing, and total A for toileting. She was unable to walk 10ft upon eval. Mrs. Clossman had increased risk for falls and increased dependence on others for care.

Physical, Occupational and Speech therapy created plans of care that were individualized for Mrs. Clossman and following 33 days of skilled physical rehabilitation, she demonstrated significant improvements in her functional mobility and ability to perform her activities of daily living. She increased bed mobility to Modified Independence, transfers to SBA, Bathing to Min A, toileting to Min A, and able to ambulate 125ft with SBA.

Mrs. Clossman was successfully discharged home with Home Health therapy. Great Job Mrs. Clossman!



MDS Section GG Functional Scores	
06 - Independent	Completes the activity by him/herself with no assistance from a helper
05- Setup or clean-up assistance	Helper sets up or cleans up; patient completes activity. Helper assists only prior to or following the activity.
04 - Supervision or touching assistance	Helper provides verbal cues and/or touching/steadying and/or contact guard assistance as patient completes activity. Assistance may be provided throughout the activity or intermittently.
03 - Partial/moderate assistance	Helper does LESS THAN HALF the effort. Helper lifts, holds, or supports trunk or limbs, but provides less than half the effort.
02 - Substantial/maximal assistance	Helper does MORE THAN HALF the effort. Helper lifts or holds trunk or limbs and provides more than half the effort.
01 - Dependent	Helper does ALL of the effort. Patient does none of the effort to complete the activity. Or the assistance of 2 or more helpers is required for the patient to complete the activity.
