



## OUTCOMES MATTER

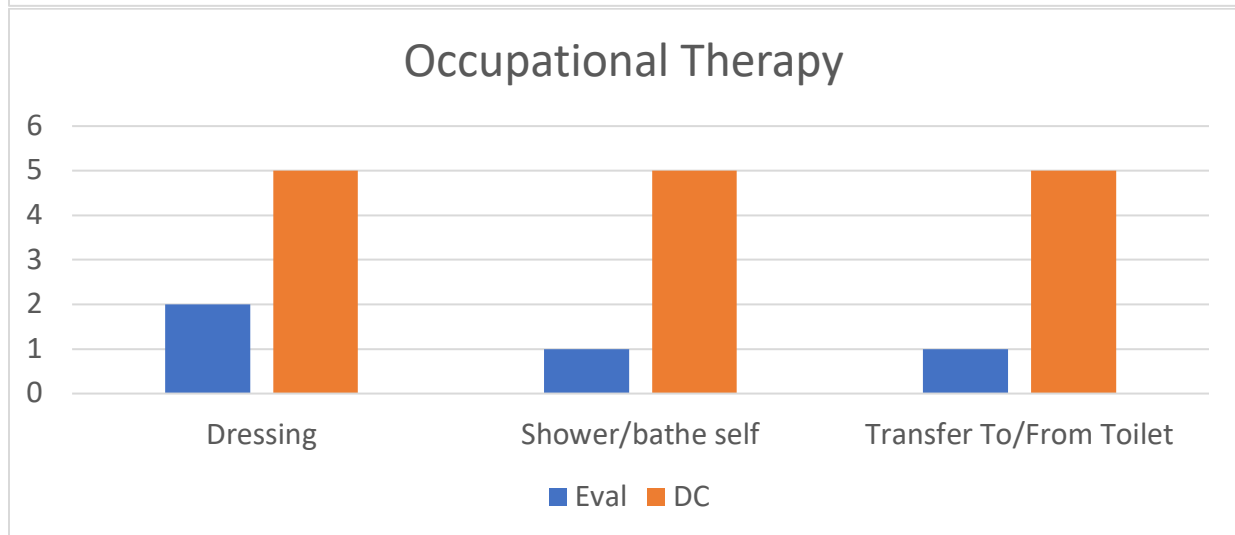
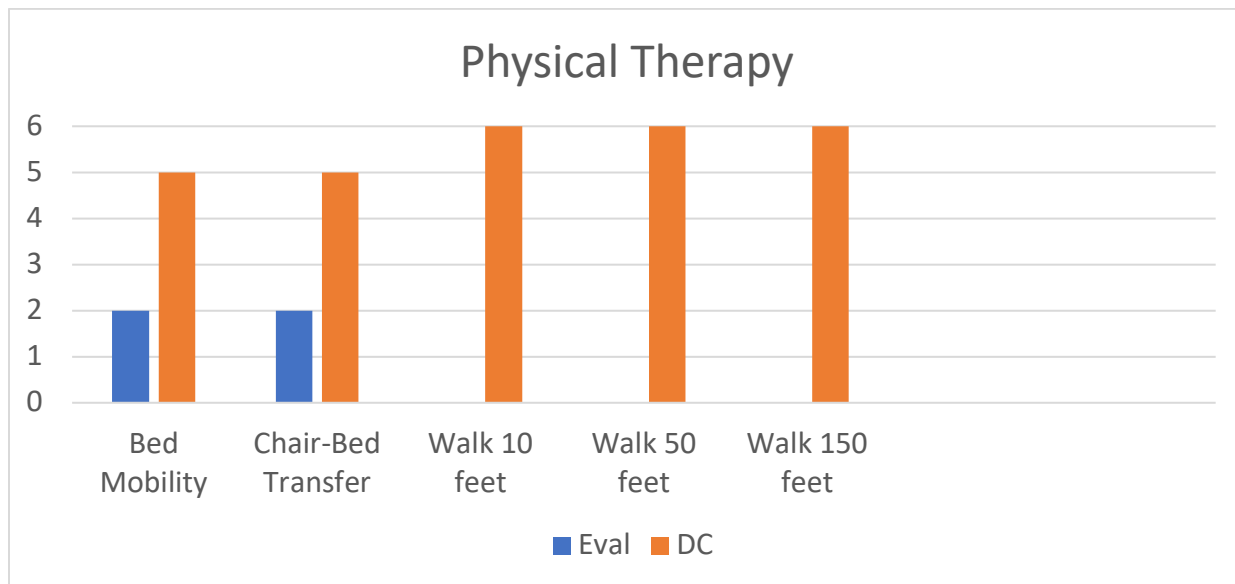


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*Mrs. Rita Dupree is a 76-year-old that was diagnosed in the hospital with sepsis. She was admitted to Park Manor CyFair on June 25, 2024, following her stay at Memorial Hermann Cypress. Mrs. Dupree was evaluated by Physical, Occupational, and Speech therapy services. The initial assessments indicated that she required Maximum assistance for bathing and LB dressing. She is requiring Total assistance for toileting, Moderate assistance for UB dressing, transfers with Moderate assistance, and Minimal assistance for bed mobility. She can take 4 steps with the RW with Mod A.*

*Physical, Occupational, and Speech therapy created plans of care that were individualized for Mrs. Dupree and following 15 days of skilled physical rehabilitation she demonstrated significant improvements in her functional mobility and her abilities to perform her activities of daily living. She improved her bathing to Minimal assistance, toileting to Stand by Assistance, UB dressing to Stand by Assistance, LB dressing to Minimal Assistance, bed mobility to Contact Guard Assistance and transfers to Contact Guard to Assistance. She is ambulating 150ft with a RW with CGA.*

*Mrs. Dupree was successfully discharged home with Home Health Therapy. Congratulations Mrs. Dupree!*



MDS Section GG Functional Scores	
<b>06 - Independent</b>	Completes the activity by him/herself with no assistance from a helper
<b>05- Setup or clean-up assistance</b>	Helper sets up or cleans up; patient completes activity. Helper assists only prior to or following the activity.
<b>04 - Supervision or touching assistance</b>	Helper provides verbal cues and/or touching/steadying and/or contact guard assistance as patient completes activity. Assistance may be provided throughout the activity or intermittently.
<b>03 - Partial/moderate assistance</b>	Helper does LESS THAN HALF the effort. Helper lifts, holds, or supports trunk or limbs, but provides less than half the effort.

**02 - Substantial/maximal assistance**

Helper does MORE THAN HALF the effort. Helper lifts or holds trunk or limbs and provides more than half the effort.

**01 - Dependent**

Helper does ALL of the effort. Patient does none of the effort to complete the activity. Or the assistance of 2 or more helpers is required for the patient to complete the activity.
