#### **ADMISSION & TREATMENT:**

- Mrs. Harriett is a 73-year-old female who admitted to Houston Methodist Willowbrook following a fall at home. She was diagnosed Congested Heart Failure.
- The Therapy team at Park Manor CyFair performed initial evaluations following admission on 2/12/25.
- Following initial assessments, Mrs. M.'s required moderate assistance for bathing and dressing. She
  required total assistance for toileting. She required maximum assistance for transfers and bed mobility and unable to walk.

#### AT DISCHARGE:

- Following 23 days of skilled physical rehab, she demonstrated significant improvements in her functional mobility and ability to perform activities of daily living.
- Mrs. M. is now minimal assistance for bathing and dressing, moderate assistance for toileting. She is now stand by assistance with bed mobility, contact guard for transfers and able to ambulate 100ft with a rolling walker with contact guard assistance.
- Mrs. M. was successfully discharged home with home health therapy.

- Mrs. T. is now supervision with bathing, toileting and dressing. She requires stand by assistance with bed mobility and contact guard with transfers. She can ambulate 100 ft with contact guard assistance with a rolling walker.
