Short-Term Therapy Success

Mr. Robert C. was admitted to CyFair on May 24, 2025, from St. Luke's Medical Center following mechanical loosening of a hip replacement. Upon admission, he required maximum assistance for bathing and bed mobility, moderate assistance for toileting and transfers, total assistance for lower body dressing, and standby assistance for upper body dressing. He was able to ambulate only 15 feet with a rolling walker and moderate assistance.

After a 17-day stay and with the support of our skilled therapy team, Robert made significant progress. By discharge, he was independent with

bathing, dressing, and toileting. He improved to standby assistance with bed mobility and transfers, was able to ambulate 100 feet with a rolling walker and contact guard assistance, and could complete three steps with minimal assistance.

Robert was successfully discharged home to continue his recovery with outpatient therapy services. We are proud of his dedication and the progress he made during his stay at CyFair!

Short-Term Therapy Success

Mr. Svein A. was admitted to Park Manor CyFair on May 20, 2025, from Memorial Hermann Northwest Hospital after being hospitalized with pneumonia and hypoxia. Upon admission, he required moderate assistance for bathing and dressing, minimal assistance with toileting, contact guard assistance with bed mobility, minimal assistance with transfers, and was only able to ambulate 50 feet with minimal assistance.

After a 30-day stay and with the support of our therapy team, Svein made significant progress toward his goals. By discharge, he was modified independent with bathing, dressing, toileting, bed mobility, and transfers. He was also able to ambulate 250 feet with a rolling walker at a modified independent level and complete 15 stairs with contact guard assistance.

Svein was successfully discharged home with home health services. We are proud of his hard work and the great progress he made during his stay at Park Manor CyFair!

Short-Term Therapy Success

Mrs. Rayna W. was admitted to Park Manor CyFair on May 10, 2025, following a stay at Houston Methodist for a right total hip arthroplasty. Upon admission, she required maximum assistance for bathing, dressing, and toileting, moderate assistance for bed mobility and transfers, and was only able to ambulate 10 feet with minimal assistance using a rolling walker. Her goal was to return home and regain her independence.

After 14 days of skilled physical rehabilitation, Rayna made excellent progress and achieved all of her goals. By discharge, she was modified independent for bathing, dressing, and toileting. She was also able to ambulate 250 feet with a rolling walker and standby assistance.

Rayna was successfully discharged home with home health services.
We are proud of her hard work and determination throughout her stay at Park Manor CyFair!
